3. Post your Living History A3 envelope back to the return address supplied and we will seal in the living time capsule at Port Adelaide, the *City of Adelaide* clipper ship's new home.
4. In 2039 we will return your Living History A3 envelope to your nominated recipient.

Today some 240,000 Australians can trace their ancestry to passengers on the 46 voyages between London and Port Adelaide.

The *City of Adelaide* clipper ship is one of the key vessels that supported the settlement of South Australia and is of major historical maritime significance.

Internationally this vessel is:

- The world's oldest surviving clipper ship of two that survive today
- One of only three large ocean-going composite built ships (wooden planking over a wrought iron frame) in the world still intact!
- One of only four surviving sailing ships to have taken emigrants from the British Isles to any destination in the world
- The last surviving vessel of the timber trade between North America and the United Kingdom
- Part of the national Historic Fleet of the United Kingdom
- Considered to be one of 12 most important historical ships still surviving

This is a unique opportunity to preserve a significant maritime vessel that has inspired the vision and commitment of the Clipper Ship City of Adelaide Ltd Board for the past 14 years.

The Board is seeking your help to continue their vision to bring the *City of Adelaide* clipper ship home to historic Port Adelaide.
