Notes in relation to Facilities / Equipment etc

- Clubhouse facilities – classroom (with training aids), changing rooms, toilets, galley, social area
- Boats/boards etc to use for training – storage, maintenance plan, responsible person(s)
- Adequate range and number of buoyancy aids for different ages/sizes, including lifejackets for non-swimmers
- Power boats for instructing/coaching and safety cover – maintenance etc; suitably qualified drivers
- Outside areas – car parking; on-shore training space; slipway...
- Communications – advertising formal and informal activities and sign-up etc
- Volunteer instructors / helpers – note for need to ensure adequate insurance cover, PVG as appropriate, access to calendar
