

Treasurer's report 2016/17

This year's accounts show a modest surplus due to lower expenditure on moorings and rescue boats.

Although there has been a slight reduction in membership dues this has been offset by the welcome refund of rescue boat fuel duty for three years coming to just over £1000.

In addition, the club has been generously supported by grants and donations most particularly from Caring and Sharing in respect of support for the second rowing skiff and from Ross and Cromarty Sports Council particularly with regard to supporting training. Once again I would like to record my thanks to Steve Bramwell without whose efforts these generous contributions to club funds would not appear.
