Fees for visitor moorings, visitor berthing, and visitor slipway launch and recovery.

Chanonry Sailing Club welcome visiting yachts and crew. When we can do so we will provide visitor moorings or allow berthing in the Fortrose harbour (which dries around low water).

Visitor moorings when deployed are available on a first come first served basis (white buoys mark the visitor mooring(s)). Visitors wishing to berth in the harbour should tie-up in the harbour alongside the southern arm or alongside the northern wall.

Visitors paying for a mooring or harbour berth can be given access to the Club facilities (showers and toilets) on request by provision of an access code following payment.

Public use of the slipway for launch and recovery is permitted (but no jet-skis).

Visitor fees

Slipway launch and recovery: £5.00 per use

Visitor mooring: £10.00 per day/night

Harbour berthing: £10.00 per day/night

Use of concrete drying out pad: £15.00 per day

(by arrangement only)

We operate an "honesty box" principle when nobody is available on site to collect fees; simply post your payment in an envelope labelled "Harbour/Slipway/Mooring Visitor fees" as relevant, with your name, the date(s) you visited, vessel name and home port through the Clubhouse letterbox, enclosing the relevant fee.

Alternatively, you may make payment to payments@chanonry.org.uk using PayPal or in advance to the Treasurer at the address above. Each of these should include the basic information requested above.
